



# NORTHEASTERN ILLINOIS ENVIROTHON

*"Fostering Environmentally Conscious, Decision Making Young Adults"*

Dear Environmental Teacher:

The ***Northeastern Illinois Envirothon*** will be held at two locations in the region, on April 3rd and April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Your High School is invited to compete in the ***Northeastern Illinois Envirothon*** on April 3, 2012 to represent your County at the Prairieview Education Center in Crystal Lake, Illinois. An ***Envirothon*** is a competitive, problem-solving natural resource event for high school students intended to challenge the students about the environment. The objectives are threefold: (1) to test the environmental knowledge and understanding of high school students regarding natural resource issues; (2) to cultivate within students to consider careers in environmental fields and (3) students learn about team building and will enhance their communications skills.

Teams of five students per high school prepare throughout the winter with study materials provided by the ***Northeastern Illinois Envirothon*** Committee in the areas of aquatics, forestry, soils, wildlife, and a current issue which changes each year. This year's topic is Nonpoint Source Pollution/Low Impact Development. At the ***Envirothon***, teams are assigned to one of the five topic areas to begin the competition. Students listen to a 20-minute presentation from a professional in the field, then as a team, answer a written test and a lab practical. The 5<sup>th</sup> topic area will include an oral presentation from each team. Each county will have a top scoring winner, with the highest scoring team from the two events going to the Illinois Envirothon in May in Monticello. There will also be awards for first, second, and third place for the two events combined. The winning team from the Illinois Envirothon will compete in July at the National competition.

A light breakfast and a lunch will be provided at the event. Each team member and advisor will receive a ***Northeastern Illinois Envirothon*** t-shirt. ***Transportation to and from the Prairieview Education Center is the responsibility of the participating school.***

Due to some schools not showing up or dropping out at the last minute, there is a mandatory \$75 refundable fee to attend the Envirothon. Your \$75 check will be returned to you when you attend. Please make your check payable to NE IL Envirothon and it must be postdated April 3, 2012. The refundable fee must be sent and received before study materials will be sent out in January.

Due to budget cuts, this year we will **not** be offering workshops.

While the students are attending the competition, teachers will have a chance to present how they prepare for the Envirothon, a time to network and then a lesson to be announced at a later date.

You will receive your study materials in January. Please look over the rules and regulations enclosed.

The *Northeastern Illinois Envirothon* committee consists of staff members from the Boone County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), DeKalb County SWCD, Kane-DuPage SWCD, North Cook County SWCD, McHenry-Lake County SWCD, Will-South Cook SWCD, Winnebago County SWCD, and the Conservation Foundation.

**Please contact the McHenry-Lake County SWCD office by December 1st**, to register for the event. A registration form is enclosed. You do not need to commit certain students at this time. We are projecting 40 teams will be at the two regional events.

*In response to prior year's issues regarding the number of teams permitted to register from each county/school the Envirothon Committee has set a maximum number of 24 teams for each event. Teams will be registered on a first come first served basis. Schools will be allowed one team during the initial registration period (deadline is December 1, 2011). After the initial registration deadline open slots will be filled by random draw of those schools that submitted a second team entry. Schools wishing to enter a second team must include the second completed registration form AND separate team deposit check with their 2<sup>nd</sup> team's registration submittal.*
